The teacher of the Year award winner represents the best of the best of Arizona educators in STEM and CTE curriculum.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- open to all Arizona High School teachers of STEM, CTE or Technology related subjects.
- application forms and instructions available at **ACESA.org**.
- must have taught for at least three consecutive years in Arizona, including the current year.
- previous Honorable Mentions may apply with updated information.
- previous winners may submit an application on or after the fifth anniversary of having received the award.
- Entry deadline is no-later-than **midnight July 28, 2024**.

The judging committee reserves the right to extend the entry deadline.

The Teacher of the Year will:

- receive a cash award,
- have a video made of you describing your teaching methods and philosophies,
- receive complementary admission for four to the Governor's Celebration of Innovation, and
- be asked to present a display board at the GCOI showcase describing your teaching style.

Up to two Honorable Mentions may also be awarded.
